

Lake Level Gauging

- . The manual gauges to be installed at each of Keuka's ends by KLA. There was no information available at the meeting to further review this project.
- . The USGS gauging station in Hammondsport.
 - . Sec'y. Weber presented a communication from USGS on this topic.
 - . Comm. Pennise reported that the land will be abandoned and sold by the Hammondsport-Bath R.R. Company.
 - . JC Smith reported that this type of station can be operated for less than USGS predicts, can be installed by KLOC personnel and operated very efficiently, the utilities are a very small cost and the Yates/Steuben staff to operate the system must be identified. Comm. Pennise said that he and JC Smith will have firm costs available at the March meeting.

Army Cops of Engineers & Gate Project

Comm. Plaisted suggested the Vice Chairmen of KLOC and KWIC be the chairmen of the other respective organization.

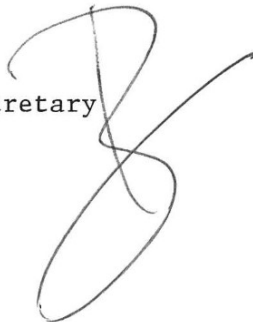
Comm. Multer asked Comm. Snow to check on the assessment question posed by Mr. Amato.
