THE STATE OF NEW YORK  
AND THE  
TOWNS OF BARRINGTON, JERUSALEM, MILO, PULTNEY,  
URBANA AND WAYNE  
AND THE  
VILLAGES OF HAMMONDSPORT AND PENN YAN  
FOR LOCAL COOPERATION FOR  
THE KEUKA LAKE OUTLET STRUCTURE  
AT PENN YAN, NEW YORK

This Agreement entered into this            day of            , 198  
by and between the State of New York (hereinafter referred to as the  
"STATE"), represented by and through the Commissioner of Environmental  
Conservation and the Towns of Barrington, Jerusalem, Milo, Pultney,  
Urbana and Wayne and the Villages of Hammondsport and Penn Yan, within  
Steuben and Yates Counties, and which form and shall act through Keuka  
Lake Compact (hereinafter referred to as the "MUNICIPALITY") with  
offices at            , New York,

WITNESSETH THAT

WHEREAS construction of the Keuka Lake Outlet Control Structure  
at Penn Yan, New York (hereinafter referred to as the "PROJECT") was  
approved by the Chief of Engineers under authority of Section 205 of  
the 1948 Flood Control Act as amended, and is contingent upon the  
execution of a formal agreement for local cooperation between the  
STATE and the United States of America, acting through the Department  
of the Army (hereinafter referred to as the "GOVERNMENT") acting  
through the Buffalo District Commander; and

WHEREAS, the STATE hereby expresses its intent to enter into a  
formal agreement of local cooperation with the GOVERNMENT in order to
