This resolution is subject to permissive referendum.

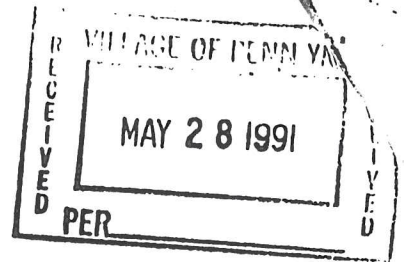
